



**Three Dot Dash® Global Teen Leader (GTL) Nomination Procedure
Just Peace Summit – March 25 – April 1, 2011**

ALL GTL Nominations Must Be Received By: **September 17, 2010**
Selected GTL Participants and Alternates will be notified by: **November 19, 2010**

Three Dot Dash Global Teen Leader Nominee Eligibility:

Three Dot Dash is looking for 25 – 30 Global Teen Leaders (GTLs) who are doing extraordinary work that helps meet one or more of the basic human needs – food, water, health, shelter, education, safety and the environment – thus, creating a more peaceful society.

GTLs must meet **ALL** of the following requirements to be nominated and to participate in Three Dot Dash:

- Be nominated by a non-governmental organization (NGO), other qualified organization*, a former Three Dot Dash Global Teen Leader or a Mentor.
- Be between the ages of 13 – 19 at the time of the Summit, March 25– April 1, 2011.
- Must have a demonstrated track record of leadership and have shown initiative within their communities and/or globally that has significantly addressed one or more basic human needs.
- Must currently be working on a project that addresses basic human needs.
- Must speak and write English proficiently.
- Be able to travel to the United States to participate for the entire duration of the Summit, from March 25 – April 1, 2011.

Other Important Information:

- 25 – 30 Global Teen Leaders will be chosen to participate in Three Dot Dash 2011.
- All qualified nominators may nominate more than one GTL.
- Nomination does not guarantee acceptance to Three Dot Dash.
- Ten (10) GTLs will be selected as “Alternates” in case chosen GTLs are unable to participate.
- International GTLs under the age of 18 may need to be accompanied by a guardian.
- Three Dot Dash Just Peace Summit is hosted by the We Are Family Foundation® (WAFF). Travel, hotel, food and a monetary stipend will be provided by WAFF for each GTL participant and necessary guardians.

Please fully complete nomination form Parts 1, 2 and 3 and return to the We Are Family Foundation via email, fax or regular mail no later than **September 17, 2010**. Failure to fully complete ALL Parts will result in an automatic disqualification.
